RESEARCH INTERESTS

The problem of political legitimacy, and the way it is perceived by multiple epistemological and methodological lenses (political science, history, philosophy), is my main area of research. My doctoral dissertation on *Weimar and the Crisis of Political Legitimacy in Late Modernity* was defended in February 2016 at the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, Universidade Nova de Lisboa (FCSH-UNL). It deals with views of legitimacy in late modern German thought, with special emphasis on the works of Max Weber, Hans Kelsen and Carl Schmitt. Shortly after obtaining the PhD, *Routledge* offered me a book contract to publish a research monograph based upon the dissertation – a project on which I am currently working. In the academic year 2016/2017 I taught an undergraduate course in Theories of Justice, and in the present year I am lecturing Political Sociology (undergraduate level) and conducting a graduate seminar on Political Elites. Political representation and the theory and practice of democracy are other topics upon which my work, published both in Portuguese and in international periodicals, has thus far focused.
